Band Composition:

Steven- Lead Vocals & Acoustic Guitar

Jake- Guitars & Keys

Billy - Bass & Vocals

Steve - Drummer & Vocals

Staff:

We will need a qualified sound engineer and light technician. We do have a regular engineer if you would like our sound & light tech's services please let us know if you would like us to book them when booking the performance.

Yeah Buoy Equipment:

Guitar amp and cabinet, bass amp and cabinet, acoustic guitars, guitars, bass guitars, keyboard, drum kit and cymbals

Yeah Buoy Sound Reinforcement:

PA system provided with monitor system.

Monitor and mix for each member of the band (4)

DI for an acoustic guitar (1/4 to XLR)

DI for guitar (XLR)

DI for keys (XLR)

Four(4) vocal mics (SHURE 58) with mic stands

Drum mic kit.

Drum riser (if available)

Power drops for guitarist amps, bassist amps, guitarist pedal boards and bassist pedal boards

Lighting can be discussed during the sound check.

Equipment Sharing & Sound Check:

The drummer always plays his own drum kit and may share only his kit with other bands if proper request is given. Other drummers must provide their own snare and cymbals.

We may share our guitar and bass amps if proper request is given.

We will need a minimum 30 min sound check; 90 minutes including setup is optimal.

Arrival and Load In:

Please provide detailed directions two weeks before the day of the show with the complete address of the venue and a telephone and email contact we need safe and free parking space available for our vehicles close to the venue. Please provide arrival, sound check, doors- open and on-stage times. The promoter or another person should be at the venue at arrival time.
